Horse Time is Too Precious to Waste!

We are excited to announce the launch of the **TWHCE High Point Program**, starting each year on **January 1st!** Now, every moment you spend with your horse will be rewarded, and at the end of the year, numerous prizes await the participants.

Requirements to Participate:

- You must be a **TWHCE member** in good standing.
- Your horse(s) must be a **Tennessee Walker** or a **part-bred Walking Horse**.
- Participation is **separate for each horse-rider combination**. So, when registering, please let us know how many horses you want to enter.

You will earn points based on the hours you actively spend training your horse. Whether you ride outdoors or indoors, trail ride, lunge, take walks, participate in courses or competitions, or improve your riding skills in lessons, **all active training time counts**.

- The **full registered name(s)** of the horse(s) you will be participating with

Once registered, you can download the corresponding **PDF** or **Excel template** to track your points in the language of your choice (German, English, or Dutch) from our website: www.twhce.de/high-point. Only entries which have used the **Excel sheet** provided by us to track your training times will be evaluated.

Rules and Important Information:

- **Multiple Entries:** You can enter multiple times with different horses, but **each horse-rider combination must be entered separately**.
- **Tracking Your Rides:** You must use the tracking app **Equilab** to log your rides. The app should be linked to the **High Point Program Directors App**, or alternatively, all rides must be downloaded and sent to _____ for random examination. **Untracked rides will not be counted.**
- **Excel Sheet:** You must use the **official Excel sheet** provided by TWHCE e.V., available on www.twhce.de/high-point.
- **Event Participation:** For points to count from events, the **organizer must sign** a certificate of participation (this can be informal or handwritten).
- **Deadline:** All forms, including the Excel sheet and certificates, must be submitted to **events@twhce.de** by **December 31st** of the respective year to be eligible for the rewards ceremony at the annual meeting in January. **Prizes will only be awarded to participants attending the annual meeting.**

Eligible Training Activities:

Any form of training with your horse counts, including going on walks, groundwork, lunging, arena work, trail riding, and ponying your horse. For every **60 minutes**, you will earn **1 point**. You can enter partial times (e.g., **47 minutes = 0.783 points**).

Bonus Points for Special Events:

- **Lessons with accredited trainers (e.g., FN, EWU, etc.):** 2 Points
- **Lessons with a TWHBEA/TWHCE/SHOW/WHOA trainer:** 3 Points
- **Day Clinics/Trail Rides (any organizer):** 5 Points
- **Day Clinics/Trail Rides (TWHCE/TWHBEA):** 10 Points
- **Multi-day Clinics (any organizer):** 15 Points
- **Multi-day Clinics (TWHCE/TWHBEA):** 20 Points
- **Horse Show participation (any organizer):** 25 Points
- **Horse Show participation (TWHCE/TWHBEA):** 30 Points
- **Volunteering at TWHCE events/shows:** 1 Point per 60 minutes
- **Member Recruiting (per new member):** 10 Points

Points Scale for Honorary Prizes:

- **Adults (22 years and older):** 100/200/300/400/500/600/700...
- **Youth (12-21 years):** 50/150/250/350/450/550/650...
- **Children (0-11 years):** 25/75/150/225/300/375/450...

At the end of the year, there will be a **high-point winner** in the adult, youth, and children divisions. In case of a tie, a challenge will be held at the **annual meeting**. If only one of the competitors is present, they will automatically win the challenge.
