

# **TWHCE High Point Program**

Horse time is too precious to waste.

From now on, you will be rewarded for the time you spend with your horse because the TWHCE High Point Program starts on January 1st, and numerous rewards await you at the year's end.

Requirements to participate: You are a TWHCE member in good standing, and your horse or horses are a Tennessee Walker or part-bred Walking Horse. Please note, however, that you must participate separately for each horse-rider combination. Therefore, when registering, please include information about how many horses you want to enter with.

The hours you actively spend training your horse earn you points. It doesn't matter whether you ride outdoors or indoors, trail ride, lunge, go for walks, take part in courses or competitions, or are developing your riding skills in lessons – we honor all time actively spent training your horse.

You can then, if you haven't already, download the corresponding PDF and/or Excel template to track your points in the desired language: German, English, or Dutch on our website www.twhce.de/high-point. We ask that you use the excel list to track your solo training times in order to reduce the workload of our volunteers.

### **Rules**

You may enter multiple times with different horses. It is not allowed to combine several horses under one rider. Only singular horse + rider teams are eligible. Horses can also be entered multiple times with different riders. It is not allowed to combine the different riders of one horse.

You musst use a tracking app, preferably Equilab, to track your rides. The app must be linked to the High Point Program Directors App or all rides downloaded and sent to events@twhce.de for random examination. A ride which is not tracked is not eligible to be counted.

You must use either (preferably) the excel sheet or the PDF to be printed from our website, www.twhce.de/high-point. The sheets must be sent to events@twhce.de by the 31st of December of the respective year to be counted for the rewards ceremony at the annual meeting in January. Prizes will only be rewarded to participants attending the annual meeting.

Any form of training with your horse is eligible to be counted. This includes walking, ground work, lunging, arena work, and trail rides. Every 60 minutes translates to one point. All times over the year will be added together. It is possible to enter i.e. 47 minutes into the sheet. You do not have to work your horse for a full hour to receive points. I.e. 47 minutes would be 0.783 Points.

Lessons, Clinics, Shows and other Events count for more points. In order for these points to count, the Event and Trainer/organiser must be named and they must sign in order to verify participation.

1. Lessons with accredited Trainers (FN, EWU, etc.):	2 Points

2. Lessons with a TWHBEA/TWHCE/SHOW/WHOA trainer: 3 Points

3. Day Clincs with any organiser: 5 Points

4. Day Clinics/Rides TWHCE/TWHBEA: 10 Points

5. Clinics over multiple days with any organiser: 15 Points

6. Clinics over multiple days TWHCE/TWHBEA: 20 Points

7. Horse Show/Event participation with any organiser: 25 Points

8. Horse Show/Event participation TWHCE/TWHBEA: 30 Points

9. Volunteering at TWHCE events/shows: 1 Point/60 min.

Points scale for honorary prizes:

Adults (22 years and older) at 100/200/300/400/500/600/700....

Youth (9-21 years) at 50/150/250/350/450/550/650...

Children (0-8 years) at 25/75/150/225/300/375/450...

At the end of the year, there will be a high-point winner among all participants in the adult/youth/children division. There will be a challenge at the annual meeting if there is a tie. If one of the competitors is present, they will automatically win the challenge.
